Build quality is as rugged as you'd expect from a manufacturer so closely linked to pro-audio. In that environment, things are used, abused and still expected to work year after year.

Flaws? At very low volumes, they lose a little too much life for our liking. The ATCs are also insensitive, so need a decently powerful amplifier to motor, especially if you want to make the most of their clean delivery at high levels.

That's all. These are excellent speakers. Don't buy anything else at the price without trying the SCM11s out first.
